- It may not be initially apparent but the fact we have a thriving local pub is in fact adding a not inconsiderable value to your property should you wish to sell in the future. After all, Pennal is in a very much sort after location on the West Coast of Wales on the way to the popular seaside town of Aberdyfi.
- For those business owners who operate a holiday accommodation business, be it Campsites, Static Caravan Sites, Bed and Breakfast, Shepherds Huts, Yurts and the numerous Holiday let properties there is a very clear advantage of having a thriving local pub for your customers. The Community owned pub may also incorporate a small shop selling locally sourced produce and a café as part of its development in the future again bringing advantages in the long term to these businesses.
- Project ventures such as we propose have proved successful in other communities in the UK, where there are currently over 40 co-operative pubs.
